

Short biography Frauke Ancker

Frauke Ancker was born on 13 January 1945 in Bayrischzell and is a solicitor. She studied in Cologne and passed her second State examination in law in 1974 in Munich. From 1975 to 2010, she was director of the Bavarian Journalists' Association (BJV, Bayerischer Journalisten-Verband).

From 1982 to 2002, she taught media law at the Institute for Communication Sciences (Institut für Kommunikationswissenschaften) at Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität (LMU) in Munich. For many years, she has been a lecturer in press and copyright law for many years at the German School of Journalism (DJS, Deutsche Journalistenschule) and the Academy of Bavarian Press (ABP, Akademie der Bayerischen Presse).

From 1985 to 2011, she represented the BJV on the board of directors of the Media Council of the Bavarian regulatory authority for new media (BLM, Bayerische Landeszentrale für Neue Medien).

Frauke Ancker has been a member of the honorary Executive Board of the professional group II of VG Bild-Kunst since 1977. In this role, she represents the German Journalists' Association (DJV, Deutscher Journalisten-Verband).
